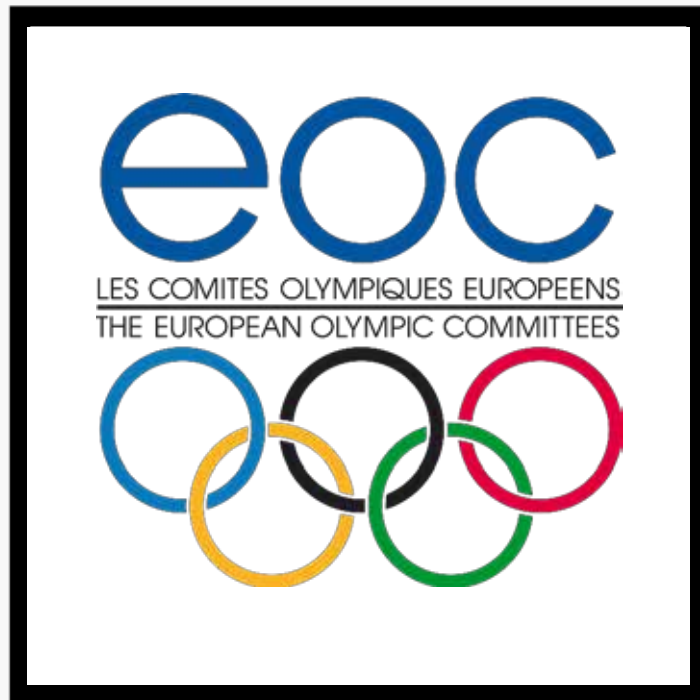
Silvia Costa

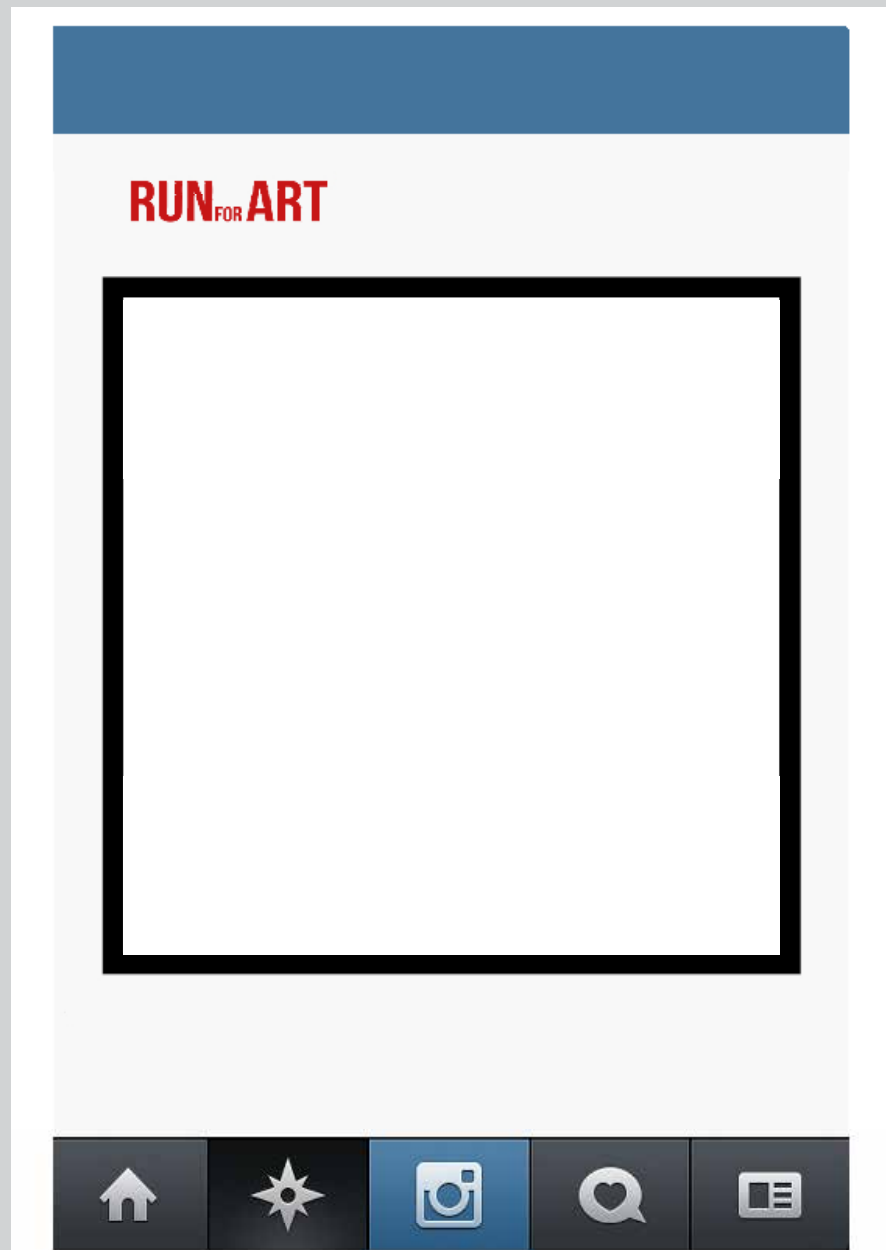
